

Age3 IGDIs App Download Instructions for Teachers/Assessors

January 2024

The Age 3 IGDIs assessment only works on an iPad!

All steps below must be completed on each iPad you will be using for assessments!

Make sure all iPads you use are running iOS 14 or higher.


1. Login to your iPad with an Apple ID (Settings app, “Sign in to your iPad” in the top left corner)
 - a. If you have a personal Apple ID, you are welcome to use it.
 - b. If you do not want to use your personal Apple ID or do not have an Apple ID, please create one.

2. You will need the **TestFlight** app on your iPad. If you do not have **TestFlight**, download it from the App Store

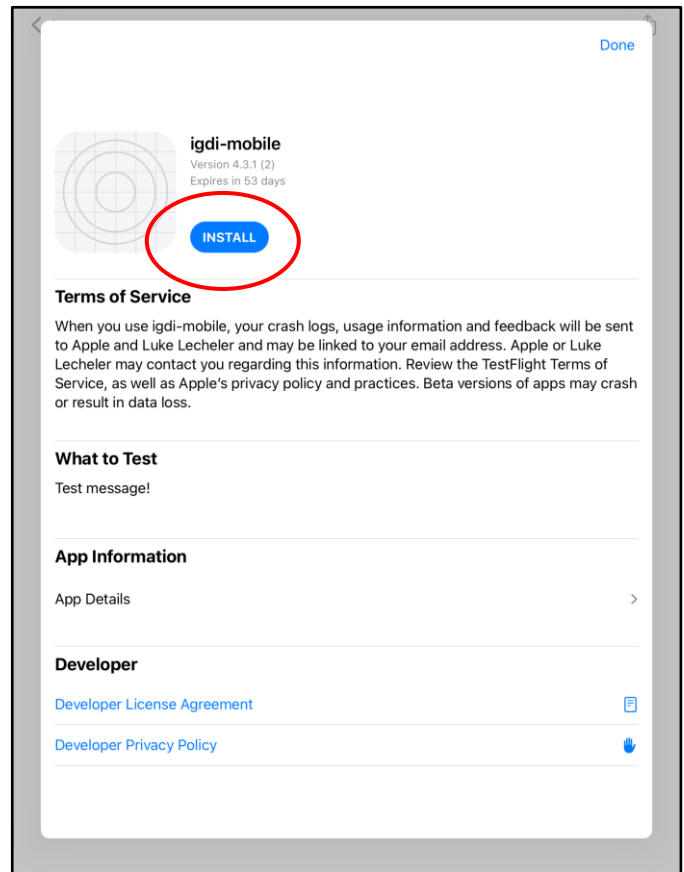
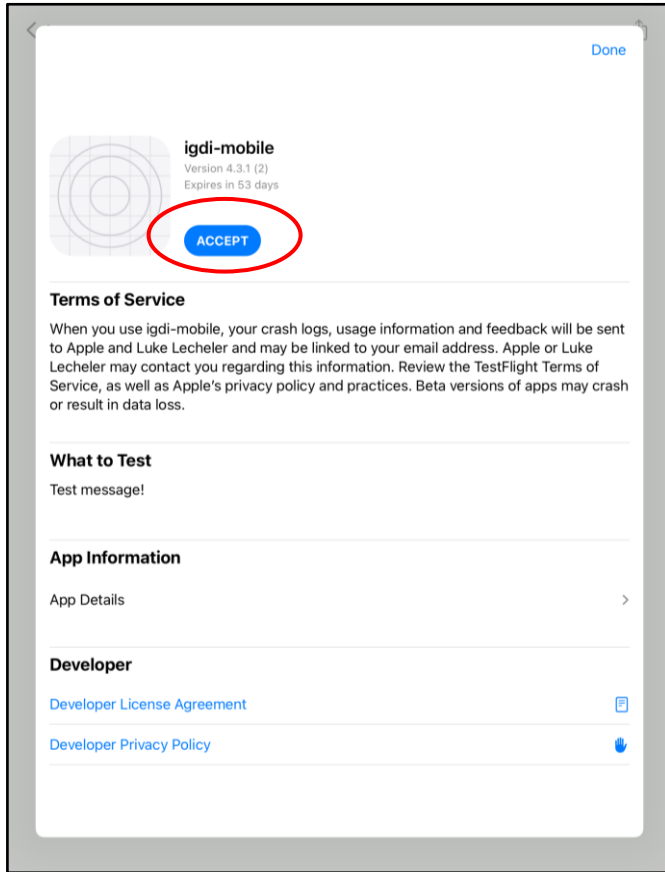


3. In your **iPad** browser (Safari or Chrome), go to <https://z.umn.edu/apel>

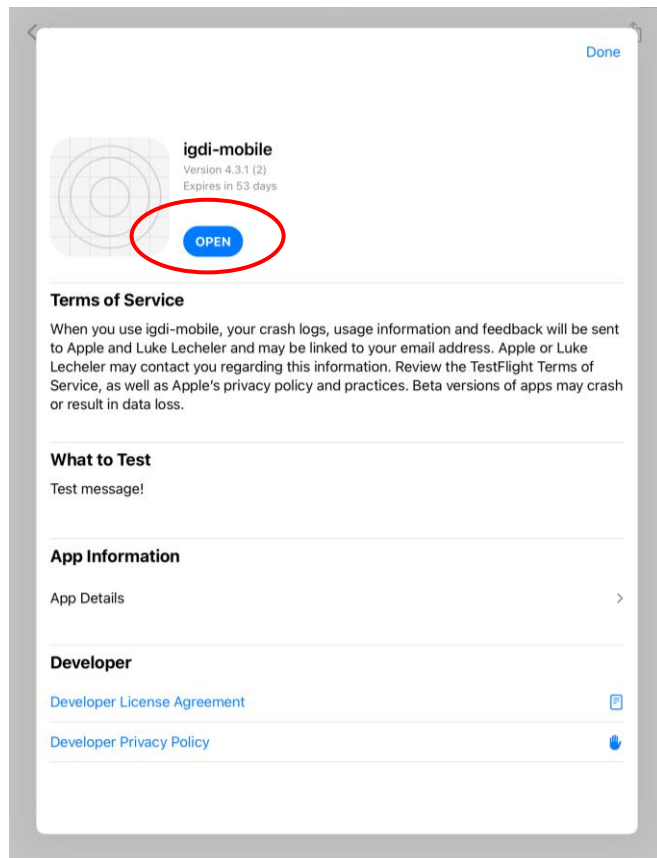
4. Under “Step 2 Join the Beta” click on “Start Testing”

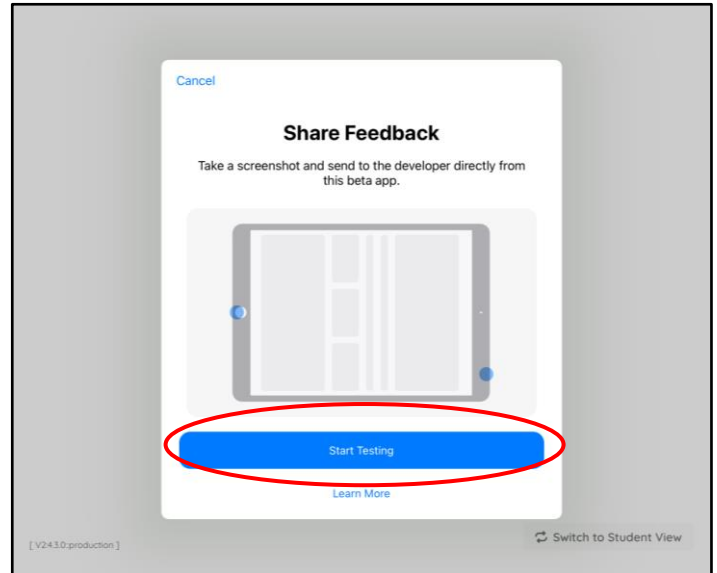
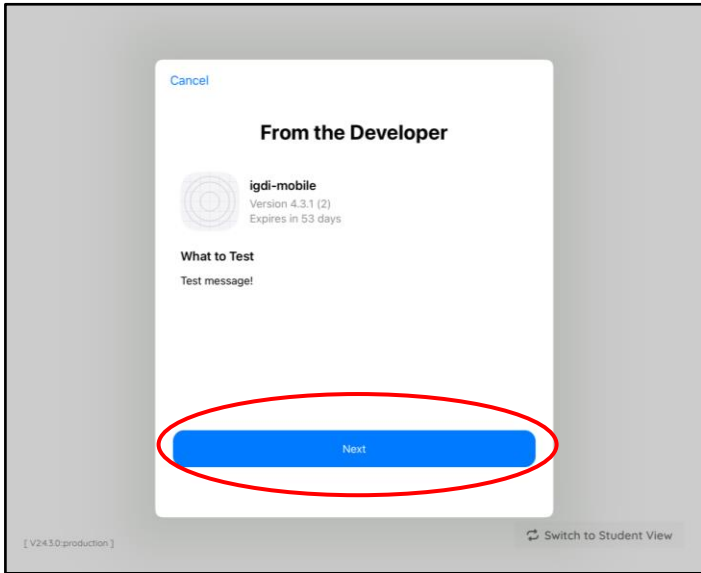
5. Click “Accept” and then “Install”



6. Open the app using either “Open” or by finding the “igdi-mobile” app on your home screen



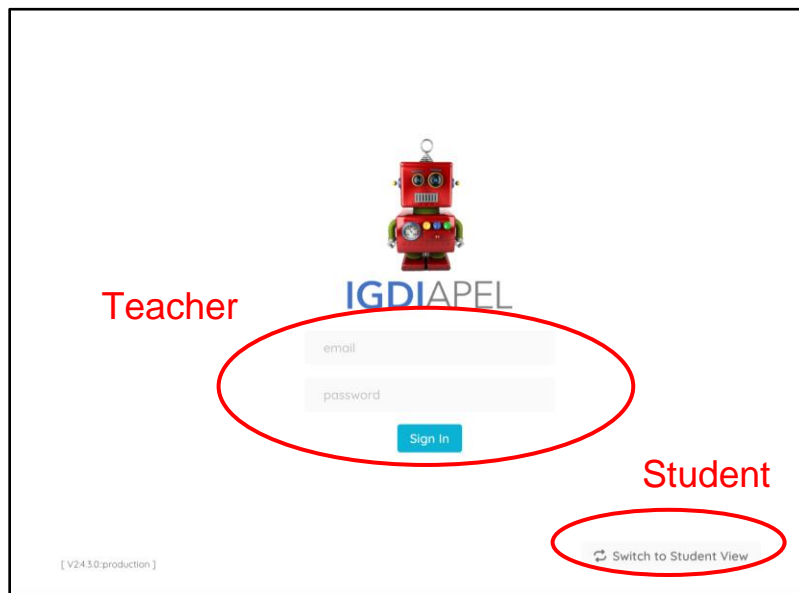
7. When you open the igdi-mobile app for the first time, follow the prompts



8. On the teacher device, login to the IGDI-APEL app

- a. **Username:** your email
- b. **Password:** password you selected at the beginning of the year

9. On the student device, select “switch to student view” in the bottom right corner



10. A note on app updates:

- a. TestFlight should either automatically update igdi-mobile or give you a notification that an update is available. You can also check for updates by going to TestFlight and seeing if the app says “update” instead of “open”
- b. The most recent versions of IGDI Lab apps will be kept up to date in the [Current App Versions](#) doc
